## Reyon's Note:

The Blue Whales come into the Southern California coastal waters each year in the spring and are quite commonly seen until the fall and early winter months. The Blue Whales are the largest creatures on the planet and also the largest that have ever existed. They are larger than the greatest of the dinosaurs that once walked this planet. Their heart is the size of a small car and a person could easily crawl through their arteries. They are up to 30 meters long and weigh 200 tons or more. Their tongue weighs as much as an elephant and their tail is the width of a small airplane. They can swim at 2 knots, which makes them one of the fastest animals alive. They eat krill which is a very small crustacean resembling a shrimp. The immensity of their physical body allows them to do their very important electrical alignment work, keeping us in balance as the gravitational influences affect us and our planet.

We invite you to come with us if you can, on one of our summer or fall Whale & Dolphin Boat trips to meet these graceful and friendly giants up close and personal. The Blue Whales we have interacted with have no fear of humans or our boat and embrace the opportunity to greet us.
